The Scottish Terrier Club of Greater Washington D.C., Inc.

Article I: Name And Objectives

Section 1. The name of this corporation, hereafter referred to as the Club, shall be The Scottish Terrier Club of Greater Washington D.C., Incorporated.

Section 2. The objectives of the Club shall be:

- (a) To encourage the ownership and selective breeding of purebred Scottish Terriers.
- (b) To develop, to perfection, the natural high qualities of the breed as described in the standard of the breed as approved by the American Kennel Club
- (c) To foster improvement of the individual Scottish Terrier by developing, sharing and making available all information to his master toward this end.
- (d) To advance the interests of the breed and of the fancy and to foster sportsmanship and fellowship among its members.
- (e) To promote the breed through the sponsorship of sanctioned matches and specialty shows under the rules of the American Kennel Club.

Section 3. The Club shall not be conducted or operated for profit and no part of any profits or remainder or residue from dues or donations to the Club shall inure to the benefit of any member or individual.

Section 4. The members of the Club shall adopt and may from time to time revise such by laws as may be required to carry out these objectives.
