#### *Directions to the match*

Go to Westminster, MD. Take Rt. 140 West from  
Westminster. About 5 miles west of Westminster turn  
right on Mayberry Rd, and then take an immediate left  
onto Bear Run Rd. The road curves around, going past  
several farms and houses. You will crest a hill and 2755  
will be on your right. There will be a STCGW Event  
sign at the driveway entrance.

If you are coming from the west, take Rt 15 north from  
Frederick to Emmitsburg, and then Rt 140 East toward  
Taneytown. You will pass through Taneytown, go a few  
miles, and look for Mayberry Rd on your left. Turn left,  
and then take the immediate left turn onto Bear Run  
Rd. and follow the directions to the farm above.
